- Total square feet of shelter: 1,200 sq ft

CLEANING RESPONSIBILITIES OF RENTER

- 1. Sweep shelter, kitchen and as needed around pavilion
- 2. Mop shelter and kitchen
- 3. Clean kitchen counters
- 4. Wipe down tables and chairs and return them to designated area
- 5. Bag garbage and deposit in dumpsters located in parking lot
 - a. Separate recycling from garbage
 - b. No garbage to be left in shelter
- 6. All decorations must be removed



- Total square feet of shelter: 1,300 sq ft

CLEANING RESPONSIBILITIES OF RENTER

- 1. Bag garbage and deposit provided receptacles
 - a. Separate recycling from garbage
 - b. No garbage to be left in shelter
 - c. All excess garbage must be placed in dumpsters located in parking lot

ADDITIONAL NOTES

Tent Policy for Park Shelter Rentals

TENTS OVER 10' X 10' NEED VILLAGE APPROVAL. THE APPROVAL PROCESS WOULD BE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Customer needs to indicate the type and size of the tent
- 2. Provide the tent location on a park map for approval

a. We need this on a map, not just verbally telling us where it is

- 3. Customer is responsible for calling Diggers Hotline for any tent staked into the ground
 - a. Contact Diggers Hotline at least THREE (3) working days before the event (811 or 800-242-8511)
- 4. Green Bay Metro Fire Department will need to inspect tents before usage at the event
